- Best practices (Pathways to violence; FERPA and information sharing; Special education)

Level 2: Application of the CSTAG model

- Transient threat cases
- Serious and Very Serious Substantive threat cases
- Case management
- Implementation

Advanced Training (Review): Comprehensive School Threat Assessment Guidelines

This training is designed for existing teams who have completed Levels 1 and 2 of CSTAG (new members on established teams are welcome). This Level 3 CSTAG refresher training is available through a half-day workshop. Topics include:

Concept of threat assessment

- · Interviewing to identify the four threat categories; the safety interview
- Best practices (3 case exercises on errors in threat assessment; review of meetings, coaching, and threats to self)
- FERPA and information sharing
- Fairness and equity, role of law enforcement
- Case management and interviewing exercise
